



Mobile Phone Cozy (Polo Neck Phone Sock)

This lovely little mobile phone cozy can be knitted using just one of Opal's mini balls of sock yarn and the pattern is written for double pointed needles and straight needles, so anyone can have a go! The handle can be looped around a belt or handbag and the polo neck of the cozy means that the phone won't fall out, but is easy to remove when you need to take a call in a hurry!

Material

1 mini ball of Opal sock wool or any leftover 4ply yarn.
1 set of 2.5mm double pointed needles
OR 1 set of 2.5mm straight needles (see separate instructions)

Abbreviations:

Sts - stitches | stst - stocking stitch | K - Knit | P - Purl



Tips

The size of this case is designed to fit most mobile phones. To make the cozy to fit your phone, measure around the phone in centimetres and multiply by 3 (number of sts per cm), rounding up to an even number of sts.

Instructions for Cozy using Double Pointed Needles

Cast on 32 sts and distribute evenly between three of the needles. Using the 4th to work the sts, work 5cm (2") in K2, P2 rib.

Next row. (K) Increase 6 sts evenly over the round (38sts)

Continue knitting in rounds in stst (K every round) until the cozy measures 15cm (6") from beginning, or fits your mobile phone.

Distribute the stitches over two needles and use the third to cast off using the three needle cast off method.

To make the I-Cord, cast on 5 sts using double pointed needles. Slide sts to other end of needle, taking yarn behind the needle, K sts. Repeat this until the I-cord measures 26cm (10^{1/4}") Cast off.

Instructions for Cozy using straight needles

Cast on 34 sts and work 5cm (2") in K2, P2 rib.

Next row. (K) Increase 6 sts evenly across the row (40sts)

Continue working in stst until the cozy measures 15cm (6") from beginning, or fits your mobile phone. Cast off. Carefully sew up sides and base of Cozy.

To make the I-Cord, cast on 5 sts. Work in stst until the I-cord measures 26cm (10^{1/4}") Cast off. Sew up sides and attach to Cozy.
